

What is the Indiana Choice Scholarship?

The Indiana Choice Scholarship was created to give as many Indiana families as possible the opportunity to select the best school for their child.

The Choice Scholarship achieves this goal by providing state-funded scholarships to eligible Indiana students that help to offset the tuition cost at participating schools.

The Indiana Choice Scholarship can significantly decrease the amount of tuition an eligible family pays annually.



How do I apply for the Indiana Choice Scholarship?

Eligible families can access the Indiana Choice Scholarship by completing an application when applying for admission to Our Lady of Providence High School between March 1 and Sept. 1, 2022 or between Nov. 1, 2022 and Jan. 15, 2023.

Choice Scholarship Awards

Eligible families may receive an Indiana Choice Scholarship. (2022 levels, expected to increase in 2023)
The amount of each scholarship varies depending on the eligible family's resident legal school corporation in which the eligible family lives, as seen below:

Choice Scholarship Example

For a family of a deanery student living in Greater Clark County that is eligible for a Choice Scholarship.

2021-22 Deanery Student Tuition	\$13,555
Choice Scholarship example	-\$5,957
Annual Tuition*	\$7,598

Students may also be eligible for additional, tuition assistance based on need.

Indiana Choice Scholarship Eligibility

To qualify for the Indiana Choice Scholarship Program, students must satisfy the following three criteria:

1. A student must:
 - a. Have legal settlement in Indiana
 - b. Be between the ages of 5 and 22 by August 1st; **AND**
 - c. Be accepted into a participating Choice Scholarship school.
2. A student must be a member of a household that meets the income eligibility criteria (listed in the chart below).
3. A student must meet the requirements for ONE of eight tracks (listed on next panel).

Income Requirements

(300% of free and reduced lunch level)

- Household of 2: \$101,620.50
- Household of 3: \$127,620.50
- Household of 4: \$154,012.50
- Household of 5: \$180,208.50
- Household of 6: \$206,404.50

Choice Scholarship Tracks *

1. *Previous Choice Track*

The student received a Choice Scholarship in a prior school year OR received a Choice Scholarship in the immediately preceding school year but exited the participating school prior to the end of the school year.

2. *Previous SGO Track*

The student received an SGO scholarship from an approved Scholarship Granting Organization in a previous school year.

3. *Special Education Track*

The student has a disability that requires special education AND an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or Individualized Service Plan (ISP).

4. *"F" Public School Track*

The student is zoned to attend a specific school based on their residence that has been assigned an "F" grade.

5. *Two semesters in a Public School Track*

The student has been enrolled in grades K-12 in a public or charter school in Indiana for at least two semesters immediately preceding the first semester in the participating Choice school.

6. *Sibling Track*

The student has a sibling who received either a Choice Scholarship or an SGO Scholarship in a prior school year.

7. *Pre-K Track*

The student received and used an Early Education Grant to attend Pre-K at a participating school and is applying the Choice Scholarship to the same school.

8. *Foster Track*

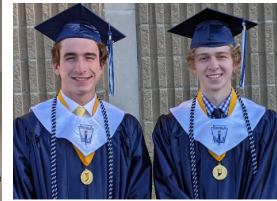
A student must be placed in foster care, as defined in iC 31-9-2-46.7. Foster Children are automatically income eligible.
