# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

## Foundations anchor us in times of uncertainty

As we close the books on the 2019-2020 fiscal year, we pause and look back upon a year of uncertainty in which Our Lady's school and Her foundations were the bedrock for our Providence community. During this period of "shelter in place" and eventual "social distancing," our school was able to stand upon years of sound financial planning and close the fiscal year end with zero debt despite the pandemic's impact on our nation.

Our strong financial foundation has allowed the school to acquire the property at the entrance of our school to creatively redesign our entrance to the campus. We continue to operate with modest positive cash flows and prudent cash reserves. These tenets have allowed us to pay every wage or salary during the "shelter in place" order by the governor. Further, these financial foundations have allowed us to continue distribution of financial aid in excess of \$1.1 million annually during these difficult times.

Long-term plans remain in place and are being executed for the overhaul of the school's existing HVAC system. A new chiller plant was installed over the summer and new HVAC control systems are next on the list. The control systems will allow a further capitalization of the efficiency of the new chiller. A 21 percent decrease in the operational cost of the HVAC system is already being experienced.

Thanks to generous donations from the community and our benefactors, we continue to complete projects around our campus, calling to mind that capital improvement projects are not funded through lending or tuition dollars. The R.W. Marshall Providence Activity Center is about to be completed as we finalize the second-floor space. The field lights for Football, Softball, and Tennis are almost completed. Tentative designs are in place for the new entrance to the school but will remain tabled until the pandemic eases.

Our Lady's School has been blessed in so many ways since the day of the Cornerstone Ceremony with Archbishop Paul Schulte. With prudent stewardship as our principal foundation, we can continue as a community to build further upon the foundation that is Providence; one that has been tended to by many that have come before us.

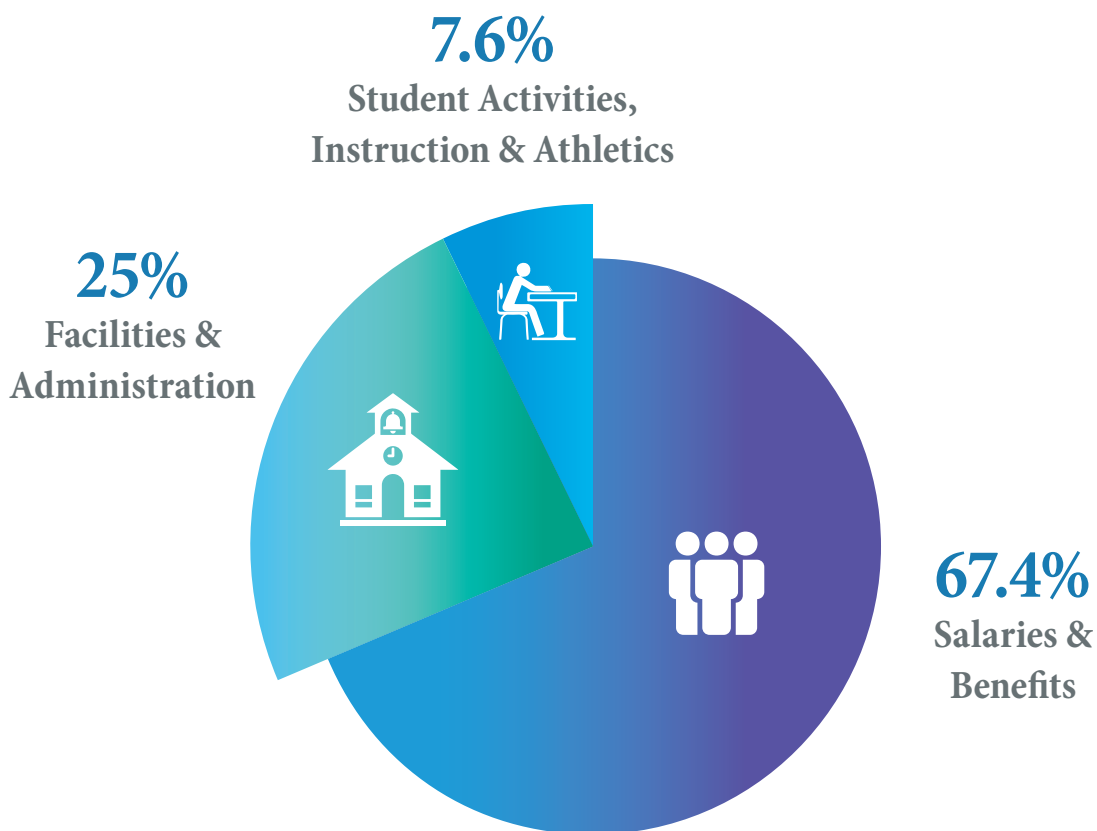

The panels were mailed to California to be sewn together with panels stitched by more than 2,000 artists from around the world.

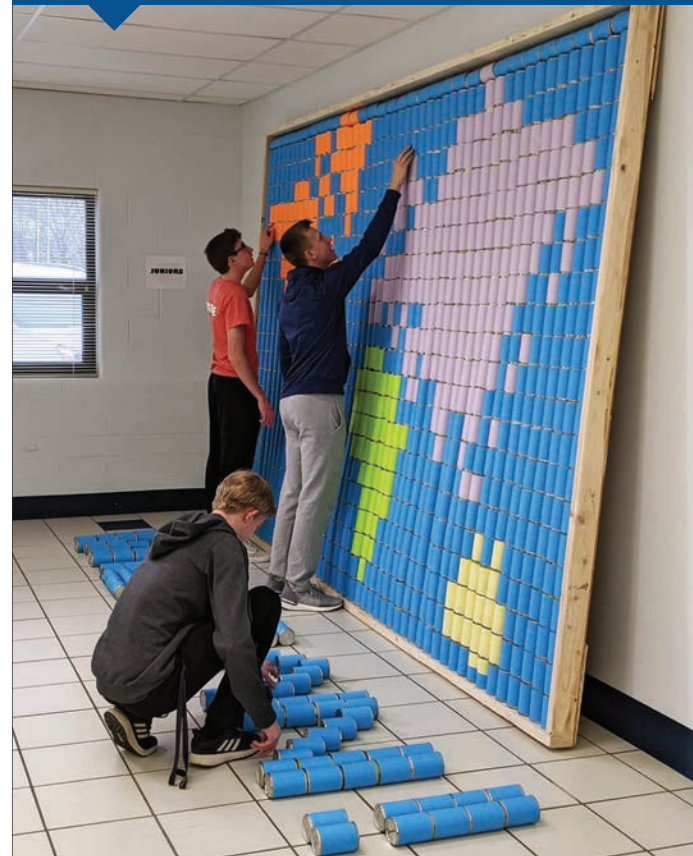

As part of Catholic Schools Week, the students participated in a unique canned food drive. Students in each House donated canned goods and nonperishable food items that were then used to create a large-scale sculpture. The class with the winning sculpture received a prize, and the food was donated to a local food pantry.



Several members of the Class of 2020 received prestigious awards, including Brynna Walthers was a recipient of the Community Foundation of Southern Indiana's 2020 Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship, which provides full tuition to an Indiana school and a \$900 book stipend. Additionally, Amanda Pasierbowicz advanced to become a 2020 National Merit Finalist, the highest level awarded by the National Merit Scholarship Program. This distinction earned her a full-tuition Presidential Merit Scholarship and National Merit stipend to the University of Alabama.

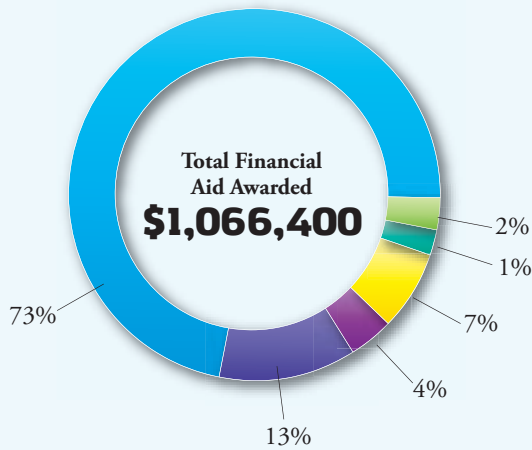
