NEW UNIFORM SHIRTS TO BE PHASED IN

This year begins the transition to new uniform shirts and sweaters. During the transition, students may wear any of the previous uniform items this school year, and the old style shirts will be phased out in the coming years. The new shirts are dryweave polo shirts with the Providence logo - in light blue for all students and senior blue for seniors.







The sweater options, which are embroidered with the Providence logo, include a light grey v-neck for boys and girls and a navy blue v-neck cardigan for girls. Sweaters must be worn over an official Providence polo.

Uniform pants are to be appropriately sized dress slacks of cotton twill or similar material in navy blue or black.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR 2014-2015

Parents will receive their registration information for the 2014-2015 school year via email through the SchoolReach system and forms will be mailed.

We begin welcoming students for the school year with Freshman Orientation onSunday, July 27, from 4:00-8:30 p.m. Doors open at 3:45 p.m. for the collection of forms. Incoming freshmen are required to attend, and a parent is required to attend from 4:00-5:00 p.m. A Freshman Parent Welcome Event planned by the senior moms will be held from 5:00-6:00 p.m. The cafeteria and campus store will be open until 7:30 p.m. to set up lunch accounts and purchase uniforms.

Junior high orientation for seventh and eighth grade students and parents is Tuesday, July 29, 8:30-11:30 a.m. Dress is casual at both orientation events, but students must adhere to the dress code for school photos, since ID and yearbook photos will be taken at the orientations.

Student registration for sophomores, juniors and seniors is Monday, July 28, from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., with time slots assigned to each grade level. Students will enter through the Student Entrance and should bring all completed forms. Students should adhere to the dress code for school photos, since ID and yearbook photos will be taken. Students also will select their locker and pick up a parking pass, if needed. The cafeteria and campus store will be available to open lunch accounts and purchase uniforms.
