ATTENDANCE **Academic recognition stolls and cords will be given to students in the lobby prior to**
REQUIRED **graduation. ADDITIONAL REQUIRED DRESS: Boys wear ties; girls wear dresses**
or slacks. (No shorts or jeans.) Dress shoes for both girls and boys.

Additional Notes:

Students are to follow the handbook covering shaving, piercings, and extreme hair length and style for all Senior Activities.

Graduation gowns must be pressed with a warm – NOT HOT – iron. If the iron is too hot it will MELT the material.

Important Note for Graduation Parking

- All graduating seniors will park in the senior reserved parking area beside the Sam and Paula Robinson Performing Arts Center as space allows. Students are to arrive no later than 4:15 and enter through the Robinson Auditorium doors.
- Parking for all others will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. We suggest the graduates' families arrive no later than 4:30 pm. The building opens at 4:00 pm to all guests.
